

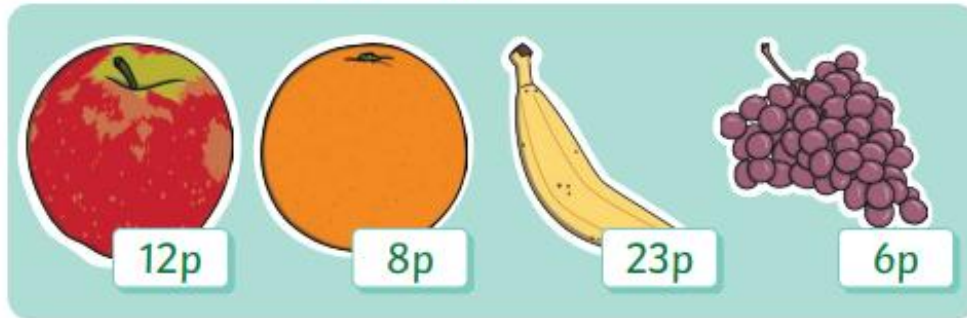

Explain the mistake.



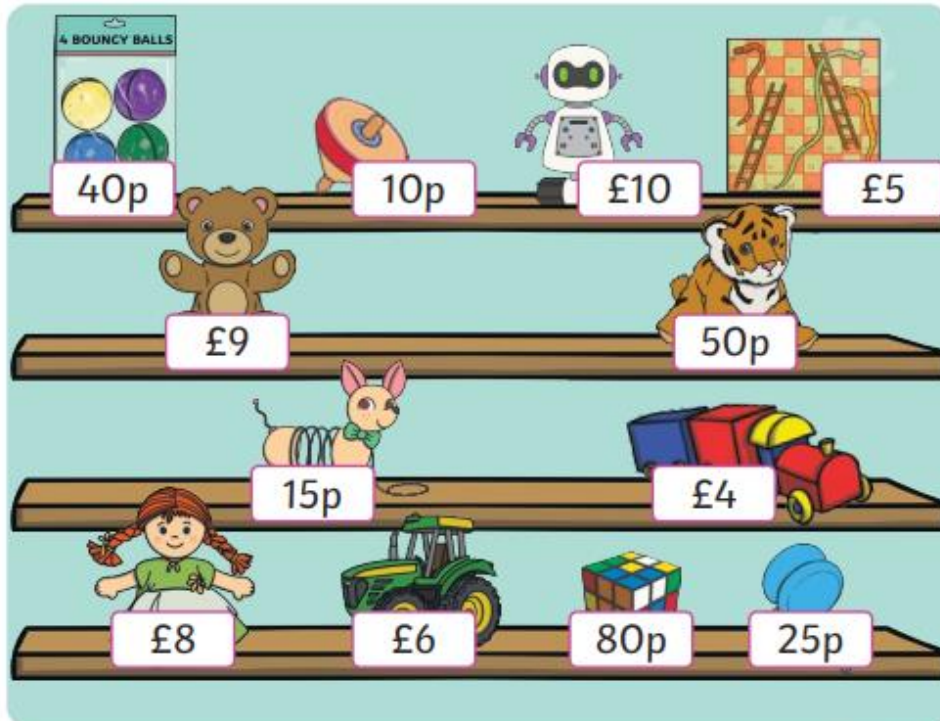
Herbert
