

## Daily Overview


Each day consists of:

  - Reading and writing




## Class Timetable

Science: animals including humans, materials, plants, seasons and weather





## Before school - Entry Via the Arts Centre


- WASPs (Paid for breakfast provision.) 7:30am - 8:40am (Children taken to classrooms)
