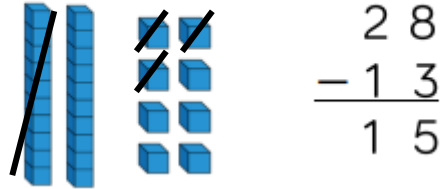

Maths - In maths we are learning to subtract using columns.

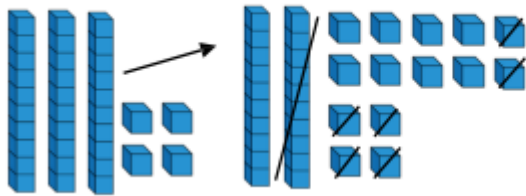
Answer these questions in your homework book by printing off the sheet or drawing and writing the answers.

Examples of how to subtract in columns



Take 16 away from 34



$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \cancel{3} 4 \\ -16 \\ \hline 18 \end{array}$$
