Reading

- Now your child is in the upper part of the juniors, we will have a stronger focus on reading comprehension.
- Children need to read as much as they can at home.
- Please sign their reading record book each time you read with them. Putting which pages they have read and whether they have finished their book is particularly helpful.

Children have the opportunity to change their own reading books, from the Year 5 collection, on a regular basis. We are encouraging them to be as independent as possible in their choice of books, but this will still be monitored.

If the children finish their school books, we would be more than happy for them to read a book from home.

Purple Mash

Your child may have already brought home a login for the Purple Mash website. This is the site the whole school will be using to support the children's ICT lessons.

There are multiplication games on this site which would be really useful practise for the children, as well as lots of other games and activities which will support the children's learning in different areas.

Teachers can set tasks for the children to complete at home and whilst these are not compulsory, they will be supporting your child's work in class.
