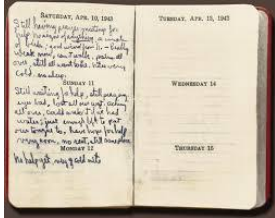


Homework Grid - Year 6 Term 6 – World War 2
